- 3. On practicing amateur diving, only weapons of self-defense (knives and daggers) may be used and no fishing utensils or submarine weapons are allowed.
- 4. The joint transportation of diving apparatus and submarine hunting weapons on a vessel used to support amateur divers or for transport is considered a violation of this Regulation.

ARTICLE 6.° (Diving Zones)

Amateur diving is permitted only in waters under the jurisdiction of the Marine and Water Bureau as specified in edicts which interdictory zones to diving.

.....

ARTICLE 15.° (Diving Practice)

- 1. Those wishing to practice diving must be in possession of a Diving Record and the Equipment Record Book issued by the Marine and Water Bureau. These documents must be presented to the Maritime Authorities whenever required.
- 2. The visas referred to in the preceding paragraph should be obtained in the Marine and Water Bureau where they are registered and are valid for one year from the date of issue.

ARTICLE 16.° (Authorization for use of other equipment)

Prior authorization from the Marine and Water Bureau is required for the use of any equipment other than diving or photographic equipment or weapons of self-defense.

ARTICLE 20.° (Finds)

The legal provisions governing finds at sea or on beaches are applicable to finds resulting from amateur diving.
